Dear Parents:

This letter is to acknowledge receipt and acceptance of your child's application to "Sheriff's Summer Kids Kamp". This letter will provide important information regarding camp for you and your child. We want the campers' "Kids Kamp Experience" to be truly memorable and enjoyable. We look forward to meeting your child and thank you for the opportunity.

**Kids Kamp will be held at new location this year!** We are excited about holding Kids Kamp at Camp Rim Rock, located in Yellow Spring, WV. Directions to Camp Rim Rock are: From Rt. 50 in Capon Bridge, turn onto Capon River Road. Proceed 8 miles to Camp Rim Rock Road on the right. Follow the signs to registration.

To ensure that a great experience is afforded to every camper, and to avoid any confusion upon arrival at camp, please review the following items with your child prior to arrival at Camp Rim Rock.

### Camp Rules / Policies

- The use/possession of alcohol, tobacco or drugs is strictly prohibited. Please note that any camper found in possession of prohibited substances will leave Kids Kamp immediately, with possible legal charges to follow. NOTE: All medications (prescription or over the counter) must be turned in to medical staff upon arrival at registration!! Medical staff will ensure proper administration.
- At the conclusion of Kids Kamp, campers will not be released until their lodges have been cleaned and inspected.
- **Please do not permit your child to bring:** radios, clock-radios, tape players, CD players, IPODS, cellular phones, video game systems, or fans. *(They will be confiscated and held by staff until the end of camp)* Not responsible for lost or stolen electronics. Refusal to relinquish these items will result in the camper being sent home immediately.
- Items such as skateboards, firecrackers, or water guns are not permitted.
- There is no cell phone reception at Camp Rim Rock. Therefore, **campers are not permitted to bring cell phones.** Campers are not permitted to make outgoing phone calls. Only under dire circumstances will they be allowed to receive an incoming call. This will be at the discretion of the camp directors.

- Campers that wish to swim in the pool without a life vest must pass a swim test, which will be given by the camp lifeguard.
- Use of profanity on Camp Rim Rock property is strictly prohibited.
- No "short shorts" are allowed. No mid drift shirts are allowed to be worn by girls. Boys must wear shirts at all times, unless swimming or in the lodge.
- If you wear baggy pants or shorts, bring a belt. No undergarments will be showing at any time.

## **Administrative Details**

- Registration will begin at 6:00pm on June 1<sup>st</sup>. Parents must bring their child to registration and assist with the process. After registration is complete, parents are free to leave. Registration will close at 7:00pm.
- Closing ceremonies will be on June 3rd at 2:00pm. Parents are encouraged to attend. The ceremonies will be complete by 2:15pm. Campers will be released immediately following the ceremony. Parents are welcome to attend the ceremony.
- Please bring all medication in the ORIGINAL bottle or container with your child's name on it.
- Upon arrival at registration, your child will sign up for preferred activities. You will have the opportunity to ensure that all necessary paperwork is completed prior to leaving.
- Campers that do not wish to float the river will have the opportunity to swim in the pool or beach area during that time. The pool will be open for other events as well throughout the weekend. Certified lifeguards will be on hand for both events.

## **Items Campers Must Bring**

- Sleeping bag, or linens and pillow. (sheets are not provided)
- Personal items, including a minimum of: toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, hairbrush, deodorant, towels, and washcloths.
- Proper clothing to include: swim suit, tennis shoes, light jacket or sweatshirt, and extra shoes. Baggy pants or shirts indicating violence or the use of drugs, alcohol or tobacco are not permitted. If taking the river float, bring extra shoes to wear in the river. No bare feet in the river.
- Appropriate shoes for hiking. (NO flip flops or sandals will be worn on the hike)

## **Extra Items Campers May Bring:**

- Camera, flashlights, raincoats (please mark all items)
- Sunblock & bug spray - - to be left with medical staff and applied as needed.
- Running shoes, if you wish to run with staff in the mornings.
